Medicaid Taxi Service

You must call 48 hours (two business days) before your scheduled
medical appointment or the service will be refused. The only exception to the
48-hour rule is an emergency trip to the hospital or to your Doctor's office.

Transportation Disadvantaged Program

If you have trouble getting to medical appointments, grocery stores, banks and other essential destinations, the **Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) Program** may be able to help. Through the TD Program, you can travel within Pinellas County for **\$3.00 each way**, regardless of distance.

To qualify for the **TD program**, you must show that you have no other means of transportation, including family, friends or the bus system, and also have income of less than 200% of the Federal Poverty level. Currently this limit is \$1,702 per month for one person and \$2,282 per month for two persons. It's higher for families with more than two persons in the household.

Once you've qualified for the **TD program**, you simply call at least 48 hours in advance to arrange transportation. The number to call will be provided with your eligibility notice.

The cost per ride is **\$3.00 each way, due in cash at the time of the ride**. A 31-day unlimited bus pass is also available for \$4.20 per pass for qualified individuals. Wheelchair transportation is available, if necessary.

You must apply for the **TD program**, and eligibility will then be determined.
